# Request for Proposal (RFP): Capital Campaign Consulting Services

The Child Advocacy Center of Northeast Missouri (CACNEMO) is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide professional consulting services to support our upcoming capital campaign. The campaign goal is approximately \$10–11 million to fund the construction of a new 20,000 sq. ft. facility to expand services for children and families.

## 1. Project Overview

CACNEMO is planning a multi-year capital campaign to raise \$10–11 million for the construction and furnishing of a new facility. The selected firm will provide strategic direction, campaign planning, donor cultivation support, and related consulting services to help CACNEMO achieve its fundraising goal.

## 2. Scope of Services

The selected firm will be expected to provide the following services:

- Develop a comprehensive capital campaign plan, including campaign benchmarks, timelines, donor strategies, and materials.
- Conduct prospect research, cultivate and steward donors.
- Provide strategic support to help navigate and build relationships with gatekeepers at major corporations and foundations.
- Assist in identifying corporations and foundations with a history of supporting nonprofit organizations that serve children and families.
- Provide training and support for Board members, staff, and volunteers in campaign activities.
- Support the creation of compelling campaign materials (brochures, pledge forms, donor communication, naming opportunities).
- Provide ongoing campaign progress reports and adjust strategies as needed.
- Offer recommendations for campaign staffing, systems, and donor stewardship.
- Support donor recognition efforts.

#### 3. Qualifications

The ideal candidate will have:

- A proven track record of securing gifts from high-net-worth individuals.
- At least 10 years of experience in nonprofit fundraising, with a focus on capital campaigns.
- Deep knowledge of donor cultivation and stewardship best practices.
- Excellent communication, writing, and interpersonal skills.

- Experience working with nonprofit boards and executive leadership.
- Familiarity with donor databases and CRM systems.

### 4. Proposal Requirements

Firms responding to this RFP should include the following in their proposal:

- Firm background (company history, the number of years in business) experience in the nonprofit sector and relevant experience with capital campaigns of similar size and scope.
- Proposed approach and methodology for the campaign.
- Bios and qualifications of key consultants who would work with CACNEMO.
- Work plan, including timeline and milestones.
- Fee structure (flat fee/retainer) and estimated total costs. Provide a breakdown of consulting fees versus other anticipated campaign expenses.
- References from at least three nonprofit clients with similar campaigns.
